

Puppy Sales Contract and Health Guarantee

The above described puppy is being sold in good health, has had it's dew claws removed, been wormed at least twice and received a 5-way puppy shot (5 vaccinations in 1 shot) at 6/7 weeks (and if still with us was given another puppy shot at 9, 12, and 16 weeks. This puppy has been desexed (spay/neutered).

General Guarantee: If your puppy develops symptoms of canine parvovirus, canine distemper, or hepatitis within 5 days of purchase and is examined by a veterinarian who issues a diagnosis stating that the puppy was infected prior to leaving our facility, we will refund an amount, no more than half the price of the puppy cost (not including shipping) for treatment of the infection. The puppy may also be returned for a replacement puppy within 3 days of diagnosis. Any shipping costs to return the puppy for a replacement are the responsibility of the Purchaser. Breeder reserves the right to have a 2nd opinion done before a replacement puppy is provided. A copy of the veterinarian's diagnosis must be provided to Breeder before any money is refunded or puppy is replaced. A replacement puppy will not be offered for slight genetic and non-life threatening defects such as: umbilical hernia, undescended testicle, underbite or overbite.

Genetic Guarantee: The above described puppy will be guaranteed from any genetic defect of the hips, elbows and eyes for a period of up to 26 months.

- Eye Defects: This requires an exam by a certified Canine Ophthalmologist and a signed statement of diagnosis as well as all medical documentation from date of purchase to current.
- Hip/Elbow Defects: * An evaluation of hips must be completed by OFA when the puppy is 18-26 months of age for a puppy to be returned for hip dysplasia. This will be done at the Purchaser's expense. If the Puppy is diagnosed by OFA as being severely dysplastic on or before 26 months of age, the Purchaser must submit a copy of the OFA report to the Breeder. An evaluation of elbows may be done by 1 yr of age. A veterinarian cannot make the diagnosis, it can only be made by OFA accredited hip/elbow specialist certifiers and the Puppy must be sedated for the radiograph to be taken.

In the event of a genetic defect covered by this guarantee, a detailed letter from the Purchaser's veterinarian describing the exact nature of the illness or defect must be presented for replacement. Evaluation of the hips by OFA with results of Fair, Good or Excellent are recognized as normal hips and an OFA number will be assigned. These ratings are recognized as healthy hips and will not be eligible for a replacement puppy.

The purchaser has several options if the puppy/dog has a genetic defect (hip/elbow dysplasia or eye defect).

- If the puppy/dog does need to be laid to rest because of the severity of the defect, the purchaser may choose to receive a replacement puppy of the same value (f1b for f1b, multigen for multigen, labradoodle for labradoodle, goldendoodle for goldendoodle) within 1 year of defect diagnosis.
- If the purchaser chooses to keep the puppy/dog and keep up with the condition there are two options:
 1. The purchaser can choose to have half the purchase price refunded (not including shipping) to help cover for the costs of caring for the puppy/dog and no replacement puppy is provided.

OR

2. The purchaser can choose to have a replacement puppy instead of having money refunded. We do not require the defective dog be returned to us. We know you love and care for the dog and wouldn't expect you to part with it at a time when it needs you.

Purchasers will be required to show to the Breeder veterinary receipts and medical records as indicated above. Breeder reserves the right to have an additional examination by the veterinary clinic of our choice prior to providing a new puppy.

THE GUARANTEE IS VALID ONLY IF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:

- Complete and accurate health records are maintained for a period of 26 months that includes all preventative care such as vaccinations including heart wormer and a rabies vaccination after 4 months of age. The Puppy should be kept on a flea and tick preventative as well as a monthly worm guard preventative. Copies of these records will be required to be submitted to Breeder if Purchaser is requesting a replacement. This health guarantee is void if the puppy has not been given necessary vaccinations, regular heart worm, and flea and tick preventatives.
- This guarantee is only applicable to the above-named Purchaser, the first owner. If the puppy has been sold, or given away, the health guarantee becomes void.
- If the puppy has been physically injured or abused in any manner, this guarantee is void.
- If the puppy is subjected to strenuous exercise (long jogs under 18 months of age, jumping from elevated areas such as truck tailgates) which places undue stress on the joints causing hip problems this guarantee is void.
- If this puppy is ever allowed to become overweight causing stress of the joints this guarantee is void.

PUPPIES ARE NOT SOLD ON A TRIAL BASIS. NO REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES WILL BE MADE. This puppy/dog must never be placed with a rescue organization, shelter, pound or any other such organization. The Purchaser must contact breeder in the event that the puppy needs to be rehomed. Although we may not be able to take the pup/dog back on our premises at that time, due to limited space, we will help to rehome the dog and require you provide us with the new owner's contact information so we are able to stay in contact with the new owner of our puppy. **Purchasing a puppy should not be an impulsive decision and it is your responsibility to understand that you are making a decision for the lifetime of the puppy.** If shipping is required to return the dog, the financial responsibility is that of the purchaser. Purchaser also agrees that he/she will be the principle owner and caregiver of the said puppy and that the puppy is not being purchased as a gift for a third party such as the purchaser's friends or family (with the exception of their young children) unless the breeder is informed and approves of the individual who will be receiving the puppy.

Adult size, conformation, color, and pattern of puppy/dog are not guaranteed. The Breeder assumes no responsibility for the puppy after it leaves the premises for medical expenses, mortality, puppy's behavior, family disagreement, or any other reason. It is recommended that Purchaser enroll the Puppy in an obedience class to teach acceptable and desired behavior resulting in a more rewarding relationship for both Purchaser and Puppy. It is understood that no warranty or representation has been made regarding this puppy except as set forth in writing in this agreement. It is further agreed that the puppy is of pet quality for the expressed purpose of a companion pet.

Purchaser's Statement: I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT IT BECOMES A BINDING CONTRACT, AND I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THE CONDITIONS OF THIS SALE.
